### Double Layer Pumpkin Pie

4 oz cream cheese, softened

1 T milk or half-and-half

1 T sugar

1 ½ c thawed cool whip

1 Keebler Graham Cracker Pie Crust (6oz)

1 c cold milk or half-and-half

1 can (16oz) pumpkin

2 pkgs (4-serving) vanilla flavor instant pudding

1 t ground cinnamon

½ t ground ginger

¼ t ground cloves

Mix cream cheese, 1 T milk & sugar in bowl with wire whisk until smooth. Stir in whipped topping. Spread on bottom of crust. Pour 1 c cold milk into large bowl. Add pumpkin, pudding mixes & spices. Beat with whisk until blended. Mixture will be thick. Spread over cream cheese. Refrigerate 4 hours.
